

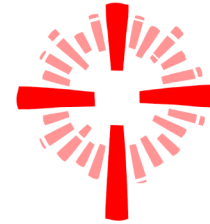

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, 12

In your lifetime, describe your favorite group you belonged to? What made the group so special to you?

What do you think is meant by the statement - "We grow more in circles than in rows"?

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, 12. Why are two better than one? When one falls down, what will the other do? What happens to the one should he/she have no one to help them up?

Describe a situation in your life where you "fell down" and no one helped you up? How did you feel? Describe a situation in your life where you did have at least one person to pick you up when you fell. How did you feel in this situation?

What should a life group look like to you? How has being in a life group strengthened your relationship with God? What have you learned about people in general just by being in your life group? What has God taught you about love and relationships through your life group experience?

If you are currently not in a life group, what are you letting get in the way of being in one? How will you ask Jesus to help you overcome this obstacle so that you are part of a life group?
